**How does Jesus feel when He sees us grieving?** To the widow of Nain, it says in Luke 7:13 "When the Lord saw her, his heart went out to her...". When Jesus saw the grieving of Mary at the tomb of Lazarus in the gospel of John says in 11:33-35 "33 When Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who had come along with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in spirit and troubled. 34 "Where have you laid him?" he asked. "Come and see, Lord," they replied. 35 Jesus wept." In Mark 5:22-24 the Word says "22 Then one of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet. 23 He pleaded earnestly with him, "My little daughter is dying. Please come and put your hands on her so that she will be healed and live." 24 So Jesus went with him.". How is Jesus with us in times of grieving? He is there and His heart goes out to us, He is moved and troubled in Spirit to see the grieving and cries, and He walks along side us through the grieving process. In these Bible narratives He restores and shows His power over death. Jesus still has the power over death and offers hope that our loved ones in Christ will be raised. 1 Thess. 4 says we grieve, but not like the rest of men who have no hope. Martha understood Jesus would raise us at the time of His coming, and Jesus says to her in John 11: "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; 26 and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?" May we believe and trust in Jesus in these moments and hold on to His promise. God bless you and if you are grieving, may the presence of Jesus be your strength. Keep fired up, Mark
