"He Came to Jesus at Night"

Nicodemus had it all together. He was a Pharisee, which meant he strictly obeyed the Law. He was a member of the Sanhedrin, which meant he was a leader of the Jewish community. In John 3, it says that he came to Jesus at night. Why night? We don't know. But it appears to me that he comes as a representative of the Jewish religious leadership to ask questions of Jesus. They had seen or heard about the miracles Jesus performed. Jesus' first words to Nicodemus were, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again". Why would Jesus begin with such a difficult and confusing statement? Perhaps, because this statement goes to the heart of the Gospel and Jesus' purpose and ministry.

It would have been unthinkable to Nicodemus that there was more he needed to do to see the kingdom. He was the elite of the elite. But salvation is not in our hands. We cannot keep enough rules or do enough works to earn our way into the kingdom. Later Jesus tells him, "For God so loved the whole world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life". Words we know well. While Nicodemus may have thought himself righteous through his law keeping, it is only through the grace and mercy of the sacrifice of God's Son that we find salvation. It is in response to this grace, in faith, that we submit to baptism and are born again. It is in response to this grace, in faith, that we submit ourselves to the leading and control of the Spirit.

It is imperative that we all understand that in order to see the kingdom, we yield to God's will for our lives. May we never assume that we have earned or deserve the salvation that cost the life of God's own Son.
