Encourage One Another Daily

“But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin’s deceitfulness. We have come to share in Christ if we hold firmly to the end the confidence we had at first.”

Hebrews 3:13-14

These are our key verses for our study through Hebrews. I have encouraged us all to memorize them as a way to remind ourselves to encourage others. It is also a reminder to hold firmly to the end our faith.

The original readers of this letter were facing daunting circumstances. Their Christian faith had cost them dearly: Family, friends, social status, perhaps livelihoods. They had begun their Christian life full of hope, joy, faith and enthusiasm. However, time had begun to take its toll. Things had not turned out as they had anticipated. Now, it seemed as if many of them were on the verge of returning to their old life and abandoning their faith. They simply felt as if it wasn’t worth it after all.

Although circumstances may be different, many today feel the pull back into their old way of life. Disillusioned, discouraged, tired and tried, they abandoning their faith as the most comfortable alternative. The writer calls this, “sin’s deceitfulness”. Satan’s lies that make us believe that the hope we have is unfulfilled; that the Christian life is not worth it; that things would be easier if we followed the ways of the world.

The writer encourage the Christians of his day by reminding them of how much better, superior, greater a life in Christ is compared to anything this world has to offer. We must believe that. We must remember the promises that God has made to us. Promises that we may not see fulfilled now, but at the end of a faithful life. We must remember that the world has nothing to offer beyond this life.

Yes, it is worth it! Yes, we will hang on! Yes, we will encourage each other! And yes, we will share in the glory of God’s own Son!
