"We Have Seen His Glory"

*"The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth." John 1:14*

When was the last time you truly saw the glory of Jesus? What does it mean to see His glory? In the Old Testament, the "glory of the LORD" was a term used to depict the presence of God. At the dedication of the Tabernacle, it says, "Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. And Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting because the cloud had settled on it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle." (Exodus 40:34-35) Again, at the dedication of the temple we read, "And it came about when the priests came from the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD, so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD." (1 Kings 8:10-11).

In the Gospels, one event in the life of Jesus stands out when I think about seeing His glory. My mind immediately flashes to the mount of transfiguration. Where Peter, James and John are given the privilege of seeing Jesus' appearance change and His clothes become as bright as a flash of lightning and it says they, saw His glory". However, it is interesting that John never records this event; even though he was there and even though it is recorded in all three of the other Gospels. When John tells us that, "We have seen His glory", I don't believe this is what he had in mind. I believe that John is telling his readers, and us today, that "we", you and I, have seen or will through his Gospel account, see His glory. The glory John is talking about is not the divine radiance he witnessed on the mountain. It is the glory he witnessed by walking with Jesus everyday. The glory he witnessed as he saw Jesus deal with others. It was the glory he witnessed in Jesus' compassion and forgiveness. And the glory he witnessed of the cross. And even more importantly, the glory of Jesus John witnessed in his own life as he was changed by knowing Jesus.

One final thought. If the glory of the LORD represents the presence of God, then should it not be that others see God's Glory through His presence in our lives? May we all see and show the Glory of the One and Only.
