"Do You Want to Get Well?"

What an odd question for Jesus to ask. He had come to the pool of Bethesda where there were many sick and invalid waiting for the chance to be healed. Apparently, from time to time, the waters were stirred and the first one in the pool was healed. Begs the question, why would you just not stay in the pool? But I digress. Jesus comes to a man who had been an invalid for 38 years. The man does not know Jesus. He does not approach Jesus begging to be healed as many others had done. However, Jesus singles him out and asks the question, "Do you want to get well?". Seems like one of those rhetorical questions where the answer is obvious. But it is interesting that the man does not answer the simple "yes" or "no" question. He begins to make excuses as to why he can't get into the water in time.

Jesus then tells the man to, "Get up! Pick up your mat and walk". And the man did. When we meet Jesus, He asks us the same question: "Do you want to get well?". It's not a physical question, rather it is a spiritual one. Do we truly want the spiritual healing that Jesus provides? Don't be hasty in your response. It is a loaded question. It is more than just saying yes. It requires a dedication on our part. It means surrendering our lives to God. Following His path and doing His will. It means loving our neighbors. It means turning the other cheek. It means doing to others as we would have them do to us. It means forgiving others as God has forgiven us. It means clothing ourselves with kindness and compassion.

We may say we want to get well, but do we really? Our world says it wants to get well. It wants peace. It wants safe, kind communities. But even though the answer is staring them in the face, they will not accept it. Does our world want to get well? Then follow Jesus' teaching. Do we want peace? Then live as Jesus did. But Satan comes along and tries to tell us that we can have all that without Jesus. That if we have bigger guns or more negotiations we can achieve these things. But that is simply a band-aid.

So each of us must examine our hearts and truly decide if we "want to get well".
