FAITH, LOVE, AND HOPE IN ACTION

Paul says in 1 Cor. 13:3a “And now these three remain: faith, hope and love.” How do see these three attributes playing out in the life of the church. We can see that Paul makes mention of these three in the letter to the Thessalonians. He says, “We remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.” (1 Thess. 1:3).

That would be sufficient already, but just to think about these three gives us great encouragement and reflection on how we are imitating our faith, love, and hope to this generation. We can learn from the Thessalonians.

Their actions were prompted by faith. In other words, the reason, they did their works was because of their belief in Jesus Christ. Remember that the Son of Man did come to be served but to serve and give His life as a ransom for many according to Mark 10:45. We are also called to be imitators of Christ and follow Christ’s example. We are called to serve and the reason we serve is because we believe by faith our actions are done according to the example Christ left for us. Let us be ready to wash one another’s feet.

Their labor was prompted by love. Just as faith gives us the reason His love gives us our motivation to love. 1 John 4:19 makes it noticeably clear “we love because He first loved us”. When the lady came to wash Jesus’ feet and showed such an act of humility of service before the Lord, Jesus lifted her up amid the Pharisees and told the parable of the two debtors. Why? Because she loved much. Our motivation is based on His love for us. He would say in Luke 7:47, “ Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven—as her great love has shown. But whoever has been forgiven little loves little.” Have you been prompted/ motivated to love because of the love Christ has for you?

Their endurance was inspired by hope. In other words, why not give up? They persevered because of their great hope that Jesus is coming for us, and we have eternal life in Him. In fact, over and over again, Paul will mention the coming of Christ in 1 Thessalonians. Paul says in 1 Cor. 15 that if Christ had not raised from the dead then we are to be pitied, but in fact He has indeed been raised from the dead. Why did the apostles and Thessalonians give their lives for the gospel because they had hope. Do not give up, you have great hope in Christ. When people ask you why continue serving you can answer with the hope you have in Christ.

May Faith, Love, and Hope continue in our lives. Keep fired up, Mark
