When you read the book of Daniel, you cannot help but be in awe of the strength of Daniel and his three friends. In chapter one, they refuse to eat the king's food. In chapter three, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego refuse to bow before the king's image and are thrown into the furnace. In chapter six, Daniel refuses to obey the king's command to not pray to any gods, and is thrown into the lion's den.

This strength is especially remarkable considering all the excuses they could have made. They were taken captive and were in a foreign land hundreds of miles away from family, friends. They had been immersed in Babylonian culture and society. Their names had been changed to reflect a reverence toward Babylonian gods. It would have been easy to simply "go along with the crowd" and obey the kings' commands.

But they didn't. I think the key to their strength is found in this statement, "Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine". Resolve, determination, decision. Daniel and his friends resolved to do right and refused to do wrong. As Christians, we will always find ourselves at odds with the world and society around us. Pressures come daily to give in and compromise what we know to be right in God's eyes. And we can find many excuses to do so. So how do we withstand all these pressures and temptations? By being resolved. Resolute. Determined. Decisive.

And the key to being resolved is to be resolved before the temptations and pressures come. This should be a decision we make each and every day before we leave the house: "I am resolved to do right!"
