Greetings ROMANS 16:1-16

mans and in the last chapter  
mentions the names of brothers  
and sisters to greet in the  
church in Rome. We see some  
relatives mentioned, fellow  
workers, women who worked  
hard among them, some who  
had been in prison with him,  
and a special couple who had  
even risked their lives for Paul  
and the churches. We see here  
people from all walks of life who  
had not just impacted Paul , but  
the churches as well.

Who are the people in your  
life who have impacted you?  
Who are those you have seen  
that have given their lives to  
serving the Lord? Who do you  
see Christ in? Paul wrote this  
large letter, but in the end want-  
ed to let those know who have  
worked hard among them that  
he remembers them and wants  
them to be encouraged by his  
mention and the church. Who  
are the people you would send  
greetings? Write them and en-  
courage. Keep fired up, Mark

16 I commend to you our sister Phoebe, a deacon<sup>[a][b]</sup> of the  
church in Cenchreae. <sup>2</sup> I ask you to receive her in the Lord in  
a way worthy of his people and to give her any help she  
may need from you, for she has been the benefactor of  
many people, including me.  
<sup>3</sup> Greet Priscilla<sup>[c]</sup> and Aquila, my co-workers in Christ Je-  
sus. <sup>4</sup> They risked their lives for me. Not only I but all the  
churches of the Gentiles are grateful to them.  
<sup>5</sup> Greet also the church that meets at their house.  
Greet my dear friend Epenetus, who was the first con-  
vert to Christ in the province of Asia.  
<sup>6</sup> Greet Mary, who worked very hard for you.  
<sup>7</sup> Greet Andronicus and Junia, my fellow Jews who have  
been in prison with me. They are outstanding among<sup>[d]</sup> the  
apostles, and they were in Christ before I was.  
<sup>8</sup> Greet Ampliatus, my dear friend in the Lord.  
<sup>9</sup> Greet Urbanus, our co-worker in Christ, and my dear  
friend Stachys.  
<sup>10</sup> Greet Apelles, whose fidelity to Christ has stood the test.  
Greet those who belong to the household of Aristobulus.  
<sup>11</sup> Greet Herodion, my fellow Jew.  
Greet those in the household of Narcissus who are in the  
Lord.  
<sup>12</sup> Greet Tryphena and Tryphosa, those women who work  
hard in the Lord.  
Greet my dear friend Persis, another woman who has  
worked very hard in the Lord.  
<sup>13</sup> Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord, and his mother, who has  
been a mother to me, too.  
<sup>14</sup> Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermes, Patrobas, Hermas  
and the other brothers and sisters with them.  
<sup>15</sup> Greet Philologus, Julia, Nereus and his sister, and  
Olympas and all the Lord’s people who are with them.  
<sup>16</sup> Greet one another with a holy kiss.  
All the churches of Christ send greetings.
