A lot had happened over the last 2 days. Jesus had fed the 5,000+ with a boy's lunch. The crowd, impressed by His miraculous powers, tried to make Him king. He had walked on water and stilled the storm. When He had crossed to the other side of the lake, the crowds rushed around to find Him. When they did, He accused them of only wanting food. He then began to teach them about The Bread of Life. They wanted that bread as they understood it. How cool would that be? A bread that, if you eat of it, you'd never be hungry again! But Jesus went on to try and explain that He was the bread and that if you wanted eternal life, you had to feast on Him.

It was a hard teaching and it says that, "From this time many of His disciples turned back and no longer followed Him". How quickly their attitudes had changed. From wanting to make Him king, to deserting Him. We are appalled by their lack of faith. We are shocked by their lack of commitment. We judge harshly their leaving Him. And yet, we see it all the time.

How many have we seen, after experiencing the joy and power of salvation, return to their old way of life: give up on their faith, or simply slip away? The writer of Hebrews was dealing with a whole group of Christians who were on the verge of giving up. He said, "We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away." It is not only the new Christians who desert. It is also those who have seemingly devoted a lifetime to Jesus who, later in life, give up.

Sometimes following Jesus can be discouraging, confusing and even painful. But we must remember the goal. And we must be like Peter who, when asked if they were leaving too, said, "Lord to whom shall we go." You have the words of eternal life".
