"YOU WILL SEE GREATER THINGS"

Jesus has reached the point in His ministry where He begins to call people to be followers. John the Baptist has testified that Jesus was the, "Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world". He encourages two of his disciples to go and follow Jesus. One of those, Andrew, immediately finds his brother Simon (Peter). The next day, Jesus meets Philip and says to him, "Follow me", which he does. But Philip, like Andrew, goes and brings someone else along. He finds Nathanael and tells him that they have found the one promised and that He is Jesus of Nazareth. Nathanael is skeptical at first. His bias tells him that nothing good can, "come from Nazareth". But Philip insists saying, "Come and see".

When Nathanael approaches Jesus, Jesus makes a bold statement about the fact that Nathanael is an upstanding Israelite and good person. Nathanael, I think scoffingly, asks, "How do you know me?". Jesus replied that He had seen Him when he was still under the fig tree where Philip found him. Very quickly, Nathanael's attitude changes and he says, "You are the Son of God; You are the King of Israel". Jesus tells him that it's good that he believes because of what Jesus had said, but that, "You will see greater things".

God has often called His people to see the greater things. Moses was impressed by a staff turning into a snake, but God was going to show him greater things. Gideon was impressed by a fleece being wet; but God was going to show him greater things. Elisha's servant thought all was lost; but God opened his eyes to greater things.

God is also calling us to expect and see greater things. We may think we have great plans. We may envision great possibilities: In the life of the church or in our own personal lives. But however grand our thoughts are, God can, and, will show us even greater things. Remember the words of Paul, "To Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, ...".

May we always be prepared for the "greater things" God has planned for our lives.
