## "He Had To Go Through Samaria"

There wasn't supposed to be anybody there. That's why she came at midday. All the other women came to fill their pots in the morning and again at evening. No one came at this time, and that's the way she liked it. No one turned their nose up at her. No "holier-than-thou" glares. No whispers and pointing. No, just her and her water jar. She knew what people thought of her, what they said about her. She tried to pretend it didn't matter, but it did. That's why it was just easier to avoid people when possible.

But today was different. Today there was a man sitting by the well. Not just any man, but a Jew. Surely he'll just ignore me, a Samaritan woman, she thought. She wanted no confrontation. No casual conversation. All she wanted was to get her water and go home. But the man had other ideas. What she wanted and what she need were two different things. To her surprise, he asked for a drink of water. She could hardly believe her ears. A man, a Jewish man, had asked her for a drink. And thus began the most remarkable conversation of this woman's life. Found in John 4, we have the account of Jesus and the woman at the well.

Verse 4 is significant. It says concerning Jesus, "Now He had to go through Samaria". "Had" is key. Why did Jesus have to go through Samaria? Not geographically, because most Jews avoided Samaria. Not socially, because Jews had no contact with Samaritans. It was destiny. A destiny appointed by Jesus Himself. I am convinced that Jesus had to go through Samaria because He had to have this conversation with this woman. A Samaritan woman with a questionable past. Why? Because she needed Him. She needed the message of "living water". She needed to learn about "true" worship. And she needed to know that Jesus was the Messiah.

We live in a world full of people just like her. Those downtrodden by life. Outcasts from society. We see them everyday. The ones simply going through the motions. What is our response? Do we ignore them (as they might want)? Or do we share with them the saving message of Jesus Christ? Ours is a destiny too. A destiny Jesus challenged each of us with when He said, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel". Not necessarily from the pulpit, but maybe in the break room, by the water fountain or in the aisle at the grocery store. Wherever it may be, we all have our Samarias we must go through.
