## More and More

1 Thess. 4:1 " As for other matters, brothers, and sisters, we instructed you how to live in order to please God, as in fact you are living. Now we ask you and urge you in the Lord Jesus to do this **more and more.**"

1 Thess. 4:9-10 "9 Now about your love for one another we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other. 10 And in fact, you do love all of God's family throughout Macedonia. Yet we urge you, brothers, and sisters, to do so **more and more,**"

1 Thess. 3:12 "May the Lord make your **love increase and overflow** for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you."

The two most important commands Jesus has given us is to love God and love our neighbor. In chapter four we can see this clearly by the two things Paul encourages them to do more and more.

The first thought is to continue to grow and excel in living to please God. We need to remember every day we wake up is a day to glorify Him. We should have the want and desire to grow closer to Him daily. For as James says, "Come near to God and He will come near to you"(4:8). May our behavior show the Christ we represent. Certainly, the church in Thessalonica was doing this. They became imitators of God through their love for Him, deep conviction in the word of God, through persecution, and turning from false gods to serve the one True God. They were already doing good things; Paul reminds them to continue doing and growing and maturing in Christ by urging them to continue to do so more and more by living to please God. Prayerfully day by day, month by month, year by year we can perceive how we have continued to grow in Him.

The second thought is growing in our love for one another more and more. Paul makes it clear to them that they indeed love their brothers and sister in Christ. They learned to love on this level because of their love for God. So such as our love of God grows ours for one another grows also. Why the urge again to continue growing? Because we want to keep the fire going in our relationships for one another. To grow closer, love deeper, and pray harder for one another.

So then how is this possible? In chapter three Paul says it is possible because of Christ. Note that he prayed "May the Lord make your love increase and overflow...". By God's grace the Holy Spirit resides in us and allows us to be guided by the truth that is in God's Word to grow, to love, and to act by His presence in our lives. The Lord makes this possible. Praise God! May we together, by the Lord's strength and Spirit in us, grow ever more so in love with God and our love for one another more and more.
