"We Have Heard For Ourselves"

In our journey of faith, most of us began with an "inherited faith". Some, like myself, inherited our faith from our parents. They brought us to "church" as infants and instilled in us their faith. Timothy inherited his faith from his mother and grandmother. For others, your faith may have been inherited from someone who shared the Gospel with you: a friend, minister, missionary, etc.. Many early Christians inherited their faith from Paul and the others who spread the word. Our journey begins somewhere, but it must progress.

In John 4 we have the remarkable story of Jesus in Samaria. He has a conversation with a woman at the well. She believes He is the Messiah. She then goes into the city and tells everyone about her encounter with Jesus. The woman is so passionate that they believe her. Then they listen to Jesus for 2 days. They eventually say to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you have said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world." Their faith moved from being inherited to being owned.

How does our faith progress like the Samaritans? By having a personal relationship with Jesus. By listening to Him. By allowing His teachings to infiltrate our lives. By allowing our hearts, our minds, our eyes and ears to become more like His. When we experience Jesus, our faith grows beyond that we inherited. It becomes our own.

It is interesting to me that John does not mention any miracles being performed by Jesus in Samaria. No lepers healed. No blind men receiving sight. No demons cast out. No miraculous feedings. The Samaritans faith began with the testimony of an outcast woman, and was cemented by their experience with the Messiah. Thank God for the testimony of whomever instilled your faith. But let us all build upon that faith through our personal experience with the Messiah.
